

## Year 4 Spring Term

This term, our topic in Year 4 is going to be 'From Field to Fork'.

As Scientists we will explore living things and their habitats, researching the ways that environments can change and that this can sometimes pose dangers to living things. We will also explore food chains. In P4C we will explore the idea of "food for thought" looking at food shortages in different countries. We will also explore the functions of the digestive system in humans and look at teeth and their different roles when eating.

As Designers we will be preparing and cooking a variety of savoury dishes. We will link our food investigation to our Computing, where we will be discovering just how far our food travels and using this data to present the information for different audiences.

As Artists we will develop our drawing skills exploring shape and shadow which will help us develop our understanding of collage. We will also be looking at the work of artists such as Andrew Goldsworthy who creates sculpture from natural materials.

To develop our Geographical skills and fieldwork, we will be making observations, measurements, and records of the human and physical features of the surrounding area and comparing these to an area of France.

In French, we will be exploring French songs and the names of family members and in Music we will begin learning the basics of the Clarinet.
